You need to provide a title and abstract (300 words maximum) for a 20-minute presentation (unless otherwise specified), your name and institutional affiliation (if any). Please make sure the title is concise and reflects the contents of the paper because the title is what appears online, in social media and in the printed programme.

Abstract to be submitted using the following format by no later than **15 March 2026, together with your brief CV (max 200 words).**

Format Guidelines for Abstract:

- Font/Font size: Times New Roman / Sizes per following template.
- Justification: Left margin only, no indentations
- Line spacing: Text should be single spaced
- Abstract text: maximum of 300 words. **No citations/quotes to be included in abstracts.**
- Please make sure the title is concise and reflects the contents of the presentation because the title is what appears online, in social media and in the printed programme.
- Document to be saved as MS-Word as a .doc or .docx document
